

What is the Health Co-op and how does it work?

The Co-op was established by local community members and residents to address the issue of a lack of primary care services in the ACT, in particular in the West Belconnen area. The first clinic was opened in January 2010 and the Co-op has grown significantly since this time.

The clinic is "owned" by its members. Members pay an annual membership fee and are then entitled to bulk-billed GP services*, as well as bulk-billed allied health services such as dietitian and psychology consultations*. No profits are paid to anyone. After expenses are paid, any remaining funds are used to provide or subsidise other services. For example, dietician and psychology services not accessible through Medicare are provided at significantly discounted rates compared to most private providers in the community.

The clinic is run by a Board elected annually by the Co-op members. This volunteer Board provides strategic direction to its CEO who is responsible for the day to day operations of the clinics.

With over 16,000 registered patients, the Co-op now employs 13 doctors, a nurse practitioner, 7 nurses and 13 administration staff. We are continuing to recruit doctors, nurses and other health providers to increase further the services we are able to provide to members.

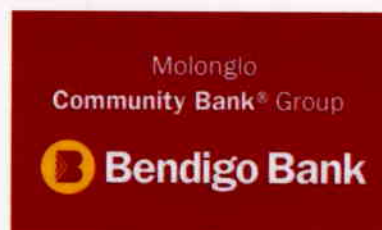
